A dairy cow eats between 90 and 100 pounds of food, and drinks about 35 gallons of water—about as much as a bathtub—every day.

Butter, cheese, yogurt, ice cream are all made from cow's milk!



It takes 21.8 pounds of milk (more than 2.5 gallons) to make one pound of butter.

A cow produces an average of 6.3 gallons of milk daily. That's more than 2,300 gallons each year and 350,000 glasses in a lifetime.
