Privacy Policy for Barton County Fair

Barton County Fair one of our main priorities is the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy document contains types of information that is collected and recorded by Barton County Fair and how we use it. If you have additional questions or require more information about our Privacy Policy, do not hesitate to contact us.

This privacy policy applies only to our online activities and is valid for visitors to our website with regard to the information that they shared and/or collect on Barton County Fair. This policy is not applicable to any information collected offline or via channels other than this website.

Consent

By using our website, you hereby consent to our Privacy Policy and agree to its terms.

Information we collect

The personal information that you are asked to provide, and the reasons why you are asked to provide it, will be made clear to you at the point we ask you to provide your personal information. If you contact us directly, we may receive additional information about you such as your name, email address, phone number, the contents of the message and/or attachments you may send us, and any other information you may choose to provide.

When you make a purchase from us, we may ask for your contact information, including items such as name, payment information, address, email address, and telephone number.

Never do we store, share, or sell the information collected.

How we use your information

We use the information we collect in various ways, including:

- Provide, operate and maintain our website
- Improve, personalize, and expand our website
- Understand and analyze how you use our website
- Develop new products, services, features, and functionality
- Communicate with you, including customer service, to provide you with updates and other information relating to the website.
- Send you emails
- Find and prevent fraud
- Log Files

Barton County Fair follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and are a part of hosting services' analytics. The information collected by log files includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. These are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable. The purpose of the information is for analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking users movement on the website, and gathering demographic information.

Cookies and Web Beacons

Like any other website, Barton County Fair uses 'cookies'. These cookies are used to store information including visitors' preferences, and the pages on the website that the visitor accessed or visited. The information is used to optimize the users' experience by customizing our web page content based on visitors browser type and/or other information.

DoubleClick DART Cookie

Google is one of the third-party vendors on our site. It also uses cookies, known as DART cookies, to serve ads to our site visitors based upon their visit to www.bartoncountyfair.com and other sites on the internet. However, visitors may choose to decline the use of DART cookies by visiting the Google ad and content network Privacy Policy at the following URL –
