

# HORSE

1. Review General Rules
2. Bring your official 4-H Horse I.D. form and 4-H vaccination certificate to the 4-H Horse Show.
3. Read general rules in 4-H publication No S-37 (revised) Spring 2018, "Kansas 4-H Horse Show Rules Book". Regulations, scoring and procedures will be followed as outlined in this rule book. If you do not have a copy, pick one up at the extension office or check online at [www.kansas4-h.org](http://www.kansas4-h.org).
4. STOCK TYPE - May include but not limited to, breeds such as Paint and Appaloosa. NON-STOCK TYPE - May include but not limited to breeds such as Arabian, Morgan, Thoroughbreds, American Saddlebred.
5. A current 4-H I.D. Certificate and vaccine certificate need to be presented before you can show at any 4-H horse show. I.D. paper and vaccine papers are due to Extension Office by May 1st. Barton County Fair Entries are due June 15. Entries to District Horse Show are due June 1st. State fair Entries are due August 1st.
6. Attire Recommendations:
  - Halter Classes - Dress shirt (long sleeved), jeans, boots, hat.
  - Riding Classes - Fair t-shirt, jeans, boots, hat (optional).
  - Speed Classes - Fair t-shirt, jeans, boots, (hat not required).
7. If competing in Walk/Trot for any class, participant must compete in Walk/Trot for all events and is not eligible for High Point Calculation.

## HORSELESS HORSE

This project is not designated for members who want to show horses. In order to show at Dist. or State 4-H Shows, you must enroll in the regular horse project, see rule 5.

## HALTER CLASSES

Each horse can be entered and shown in ONE halter class

**1502** - Registered Stock-Type, Gelding

**1503** - Registered Stock-Type, Mare

**1504** - Registered Non-Stock Type, all sexes

**1505** - Grades, non-registered types, all breeds & sexes

**1506** - Ponies, all ponies 56" and under, miniatures, Donkeys/ mules, all sexes

## Grand Champion and Res. Grand Champion Halter Class

### SHOWMANSHIP

Open to 4-Hers in Horse and Horsemanship.

Age refers to age of 4-Her on Jan. 1, current year.

**1507** - Senior Showmanship (14 yrs. and over)

**1508** - Intermediate Showmanship (10-13 yrs.)

**1509** - Junior Showmanship (7-9 yrs.)

**Champion and Reserve Champion each Showmanship Class - qualifies for Round Robin**

### WESTERN PLEASURE

**1527** - Western Pleasure, 14 yrs. and over

**1528** - Western Pleasure, 10-13 yrs.

**1529** - Western Pleasure, 7-9 yrs.

**1570** - Walk Trot may be awarded in each class.

**Champion and Reserve Champion**

### WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP

(Cannot show in regular Horsemanship class)

Classes are limited to riders who have never shown in a canter class. Classes shall be judged 80% on the rider and 20% on the horse. Horses will go both directions at a walk and trot on the rail, back up. A pattern maybe designed to perform and then expect the animal to stand quiet.
