

# SEED TO SOAP



A kernel of corn is made up of starch, oil, protein, and fiber. These parts of the corn make sweetener, ethanol fuel, plastics, soap, and more!



Corn is measured by bushels. One bushel is equal to 8 gallons or 56 pounds.

The corn plant uses sunlight to make its own food (photosynthesis), collects pollen to make a seed, and takes up water and nutrients from the soil to grow.
