1. Read General Rules.

2, All Horticulture, Pomiculture, and Floriculture exhibits must be entered on Thursday of the fair.

3. Your Floriculture should be displayed in non-heirloom glass containers. Pomiculture and Horticulture display on black plate no larger than the items you are displaying and should not be decorated.

4. Exhibits in this division need not be mature. Efforts should be made, however, to select as mature entries as possible.

5. Quality, condition, and uniformity of exhibit will be considered. Choose vegetables for exhibit that will hold up well during the Fair. Avoid over-ripe or over-mature specimens. Those that are slightly under-ripe or slightly immature when picked may last longer.

6. Exhibits must be grown by exhibitor. The judge has the right to not judge any exhibit they feel has not been grown by the exhibitor with no explanation needed.

7. Superintendent reserves the right to add, divide, shift, or rearrange entries or classes if/as needed in horticulture, pomiculture and floriculture areas.

8. Vegetable class size distinctions are as follows:

Large; one each-Cabbage, Cantaloupe, Eggplant, Large Pumpkin, Squash, Watermelon

Medium; five each- Beets, Carrots, Cucumbers, Decorative

Gourds, Potatoes, Mini Pumpkins, Okra, Onions, Peppers, Sweet Potatoes, Sweet Corn, Tomatoes, Turnips, or other similar sized vegetable.

<u>Small</u>; twelve each– Cherry tomatoes Green Snap Beans, Wax Beans, English Peas, Radishes or other similar sized vegetables.
