1. Read General Rules. (Definitions of Y, A & S) All exhibitors will need to identify behind the class number, either Y, A or S to indicate age appropriate.
2. There is no limit to the number of articles that may be exhibited.
3. If an exhibit consists of a set, it will be considered as one exhibit.
4. All exhibits brought to the Barton County Fair must be the work of the exhibitor and completed within the last year.
5. Any article of clothing exhibited must be clean and pressed. All clothing should be exhibited on a hanger and slacks, shorts or skirts attached with a large safety pin. The exhibitor can choose whether to cover with a clear plastic bag or not.
6. Handcrafted textile entries may or may not be covered with a clear plastic bag –exhibitor's choice.

2. There is no limit to the number of articles that may be exhibited.
3. All articles brought to the Barton County Fair must be the work of the exhibitor except for machine quilting.
4. All quilted items must have been made within the last 3 years.
5. Please specify on a 3 X 5 card, the name of the quilt or the pattern name used to construct it and who quilted it.
6. Please place all quilts in a clear plastic cover when entered for the exhibit's protection. For the safety of the exhibits, each quilt will be checked out by the superintendent at checkout time.
